# JOB RATINGS FOR U.S. SENATORS JOHN McCAIN AND JON KYL, AND FOR GOVERNOR JANE HULL JUMP IN WAKE OF SEPTEMBER 11TH; PUBLIC RESPECT FOR JANET NAPOLITANO ALSO STRONG

Phoenix, Arizona. November 7, 2001. Seventy percent of Arizonans now believe U.S. Senator John McCain is doing an "excellent" or "good" job in Washington, up from 54 percent measured in July. His job approval ratings are second only to those of President Bush whose ratings skyrocketed to 79 percent from 44 percent in July.

Also experiencing the most impressive improvement in his job ratings in many years is U.S. Senator Jon Kyl. Between July and today, his favorable job ratings rose from 46 to 57 percent, the highest level since he was first elected in 1994 and the first time they have exceeded the 50 percent level.

Governor Jane Hull, whose approval ratings have been languishing in the mid 30 percentile range for most of the year, rose this period to 43 percent from 36 percent in July and 38 percent in April.

The findings outlined in this report are based on a survey of 703 adults across Arizona conducted between October 12<sup>th</sup> and October 21<sup>st</sup> by the Behavior Research Center of Arizona as part of the Center's independent and non-partisan Rocky Mountain Poll series. Finally, State Attorney General Janet Napolitano, who is seeking the governor's office in next year's election, also enjoys respect within the public. As of the time of this survey, 51 percent rate her performance as "excellent" or "good," 23 percent give her a "fair" rating

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and only nine percent say she is doing a poor job as Attorney General. More important perhaps for her future aspirations, her positive ratings with Republicans total 51 percent, rise to 62 percent among Democrats and rest at 44 percent among registered Independents.

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EDITOR'S NOTE: This Rocky Mountain Poll - Arizona (2001-IV-05) is based on 703 interviews with adults across Arizona conducted from October 12<sup>th</sup> through October 21<sup>st</sup>, 2001. Where necessary, figures for age, sex, and race were weighted to bring them into line with their actual proportion in the population. In a sample of this size, one may say with a 95 percent certainty that the results have a statistical precision of plus or minus 3.77 percent of what they would have been had the entire adult population been surveyed. The Rocky Mountain Poll is conducted by the Behavior Research Center of Arizona and is an independent and non-partisan research program sponsored by the Center.
