TWO-THIRDS OF ARIZONANS UNABLE TO TAKE A VACATION AWAY FROM HOME

Phoenix, Arizona. August 18, 2011. Confidence in the economy among Arizona consumers remains in the doldrums and as families pursue strategies to do what they can to keep their heads above water, one-third say they will be taking a vacation away from home in the next six months. This figure is little changed from April of this year.

As one would expect given the realities of the current economy and pessimism among the great majority of consumers that the job market and family income will worsen in the coming months, vacation plans fall off sharply among lower income families. For example, 74 percent of families earning under \$45,000 plan no vacation in the next six months compared to 60 percent of those earning between \$45,000 and \$84,999 and 57 percent of those earning more than \$85,000.

Companies in Arizona's hospitality industry will be interested to know that of those families able to vacation away from home between July and year end, half will spend all or part of their time and money within the state. Twenty-seven percent will do their entire vacation in Arizona.

EDITOR'S NOTE: This Rocky Mountain Poll - Arizona (2011-III-03), is based on 716 interviews with adult heads of household statewide, conducted between July 22 and 27, 2011. Interviewing was conducted in both English and Spanish by professional interviewers of the Behavior Research Center on both landlines and cell phones. Where necessary, figures for age, sex, race and political party were weighted to bring them into line with their actual proportion in the population. In a sample of this size, one can say with a 95 percent certainty that the results have a statistical precision of plus or minus 3.8 percent of what they would have been had the entire adult population been surveyed. The Rocky Mountain Poll is conducted by the Behavior Research Center of Arizona and is an independent and non-partisan research program sponsored by the Center.
