SHERIFFS ACROSS ARIZONA BETTER RESPECTED BY VOTERS

Phoenix, Arizona, January 31, 2012. Public respect for County Sheriffs around the state appears to be improving after a period of low readings. This is particularly true or the sheriff of Pima County and other sheriffs outside of Maricopa county. For example, Pima County Sheriff Clarence Dupnik's job rating from constituents rose to 36 percent favorable from 31 percent and more important, his "poor job" ratings were cut in half, falling to only 15 percent from 29 percent.

In addition, the best ratings are being registered with the state's "rural" counties where favorable job ratings rose to 49 percent from 37 percent and negative ratings subsided to 17 percent from 22 percent last May.

We also note that in the rural counties, sheriff's ratings would be significantly higher except that <u>women</u> living in those areas are uniquely disinclined to look favorably on their local sheriffs. More specifically, only 33 percent of women compared to 68 percent of men rate rural county sheriffs favorably. Women are also twice as likely (21%) to say their rural sheriffs are doing a poor job than are men (11%).

In Maricopa country, the controversial Joe Arpaio continues to be the least-liked sheriff, with fully a third rating his performance as "poor" or "very poor" yet at the same time, his favorable ratings have edged upward as well. Today 49 percent like Sheriff Arpaio's performance (up from 39 percent in January 2010) while 32 percent do not. Another 15 percent say he is doing only a "fair job". The proportion of Maricopa county residents who think he is doing a poor job surges to 74 percent among Hispanics, 53 percent among Democrats and 42 percent among high income families.

EDITOR'S NOTE: This Rocky Mountain Poll - Arizona (2012-I-07), is based on 553 interviews with registered voters statewide, conducted between January 5th to 9th 2012. Interviewing was conducted in both English and Spanish by professional interviewers of the Behavior Research Center on both landlines and cell phones. Where necessary, figures for age, sex, race and political party were weighted to bring them into line with their actual proportion in the population. In a sample of this size, one can say with a 95 percent certainty that the results have a statistical precision of plus or minus 4.3 percent of what they would have been had the entire adult population been surveyed. The samples in Maricopa county total 335 with a margin of error of 5.5 percent; in Pima county the same includes 83 respondents and the margin of error of 11.0 percent and in the rural counties, the sample was 135 with a margin of error of 8.6 percent. The Rocky Mountain Poll is conducted by the Behavior Research Center of Arizona and is an independent and non-partisan research program sponsored by the Center.
